Welcome to Bed 'N Biscuit Inn, where we love your pet as much as you do. We do everything possible to ensure a safe, sanitary, and happy experience for you boarding dog or cat. To this end, we have established the following policies:

- I. All pets must be current on vaccinations, including (for dogs) rabies, DHLPP (or distemper/parvo), and bordetella (or kennel cough) or (for cats) rabies and FVRCP (or rhinotracheitis/panleukopenia.) Another relatively new vaccine you may want to consider for your dog is canine influenza. Canine flu causes an illness indistinguishable from kennel cough, and flu vaccines help prevent it, but we are not yet requiring them.
- II. We do our very best to ensure a flea- and tick-free environment. Your pet will be inspected for parasites upon entry. If we find fleas and/or ticks we must treat your pet to avoid infestation of the kennel. We may bathe the pet and/or apply a safe topical insecticide such as Frontline®, and you will be charged for these services.
- III. Premium-quality pet food is included in the boarding fee, or you may bring your pet's own food, treats, etc. We will give your pet any prescribed medication needed, which may incur a small additional charge unless the medication is easy to administer in food.
- IV. We provide clean bedding and blankets for each boarder daily, but you may bring items from home if you like. Any toys, bedding, collars, etc. that we deem potentially hazardous to your animal will be removed from the cage or run, and returned to you upon pick-up.
- V. Our boarding dogs enjoy the benefit of free open-air exercise and play with other dogs. We supervise dogs at play and make every reasonable effort to keep them safe, but rarely an accident or injury could occur. Your pet may also become ill or injured from causes completely out of our control. Due diligence and care being taken on our part, we will not be held liable for veterinary fees or damages incurred due to unavoidable injury or illness. In case of a medical emergency, we will attempt to contact you first, then the veterinarian of your choice, or our own veterinarian if we do not know your preferred vet. We cannot pay your pet's veterinary fees, so please be available by phone to authorize treatment and payment with your veterinarian's office. If you are hard to reach while away, consider arranging an emergency action plan ahead of time with your vet.

If you fail to pick up your pet on the scheduled date, and haven't notified us to make new arrangements, we may consider your pet abandoned. In accordance with Florida statute 705.19, a certified letter will be sent to your last known address. If you do not respond within 10 days of the receipt (or delivery failure) of the letter, Bed 'N Biscuit Inn has the right to sell, give away, or otherwise dispose of the abandoned pet.
